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THREE THEMES

- What are you buying?... Get the value added you expect.
- Who owns what?... Manage your property.
- Why does it matter?... Ensure liabilities trace back to responsibilities.



Software as a Service or SaaS

- Cloud computing
- Convenience
- Reduced cost*
- Vendor provides security**
- Removes need for customer hardware
- Applications managed by vendor

*True cost of subscription; less capital costs (i.e. IT staff) **Third-party host; data protection policies; legal compliance

What Are You Buying

Product or Service?

- Functionality
 - According to written specifications (vs. workmanship)
 - Stand-alone
 - **Requires add-ons**
 - Integration
 - Does your infrastructure support it?
 - Does it communicate with other programs?
 - Support and maintenance



What Are You Buying (cont'd)

• Warranties

Development based on specifications Completion date NOT "as-is" Title/License grant No infringement





Who Owns What?

Property

- The Product/Technology Modifications
- The Deliverables
 - Templates Raw Data Work Product



Who Owns What? (cont'd)

- In Aggregate and Anonymized
 - For what purpose?
 - Revocable?
 - Audit rights
- Feedback
- Can you take it with you?/Portability
 - By when? In what form?



Why it Matters

Performance

- Service Level Expectations... Get the product/service you expect
- In all material respects
- In accordance with documentation
- Includes updates... Updates cannot decrease base service



Why it Matters (cont'd)

Liabilities

• Infringement

Third-party rights Reliance on open source? Any customization? Damages

Indemnity

Limitations



Why it Matters (cont'd even more!)

• Data security

Compliance with applicable laws and regulations Privacy requirements (State, Federal, and International)
