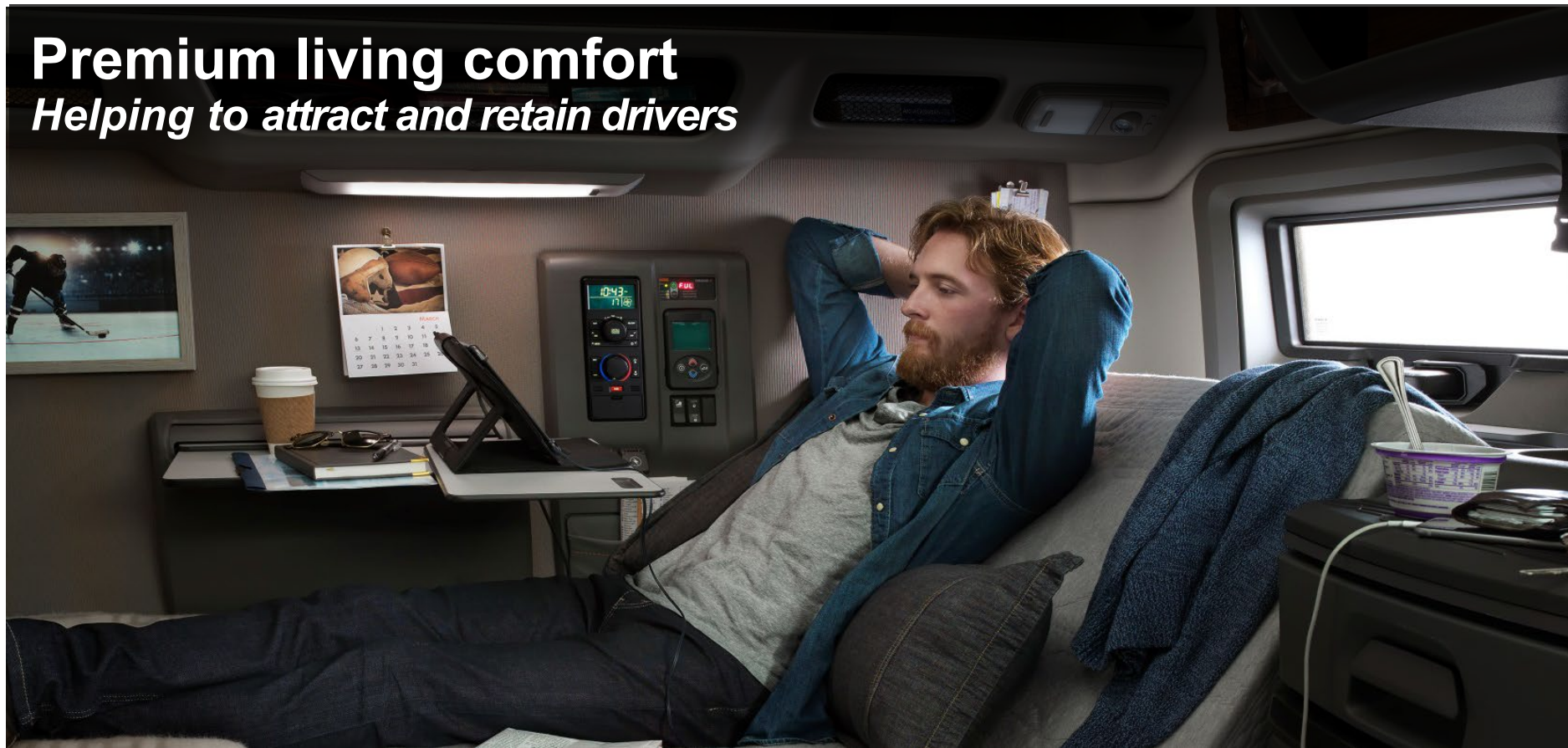

# Fuel savings

- Weight benefits of a 6x2 over 6x4 when all axles are down
- Forward axle distributes loads
- Axle lifted provides 4x2 fuel efficiency
- Optimized tire package on the lifted axle tires for better lower rolling resistance



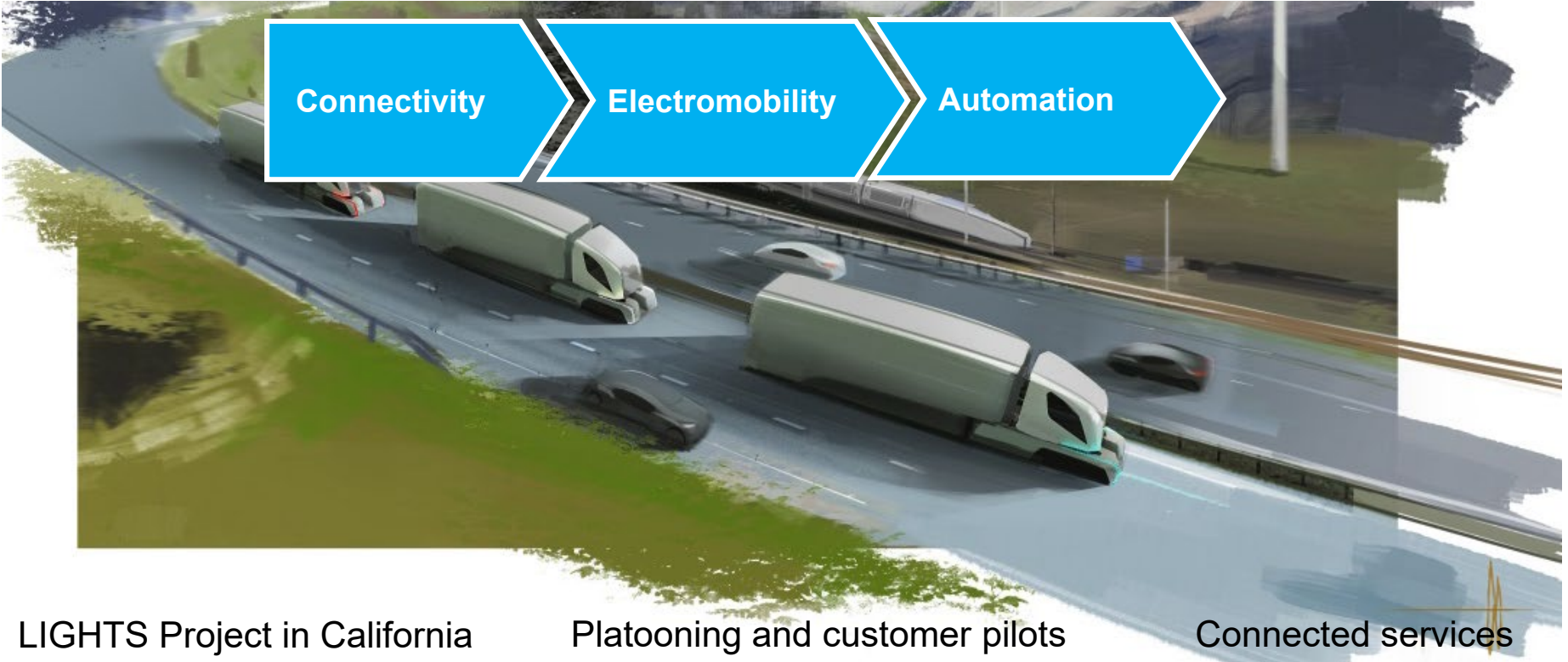


# Maintenance savings

- Reduced brake wear and replacement on forward axle
- Preventative maintenance costs could be reduced
- Tire replacement and less wear on tires
- More consistent load on steer axle provides better front axle tire life

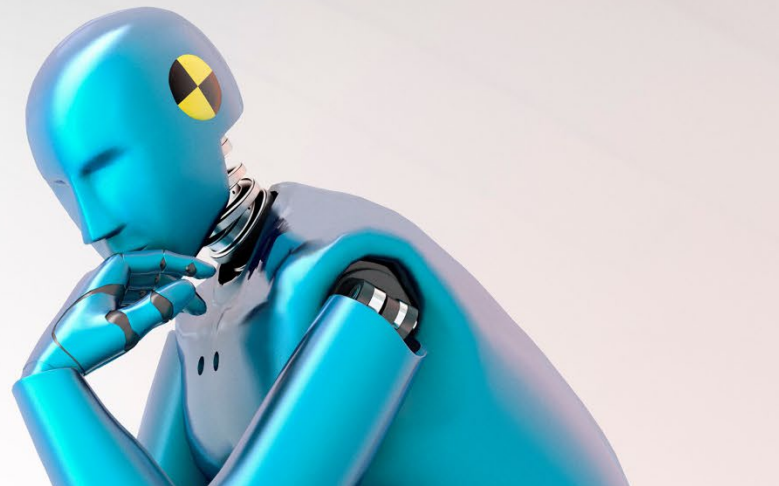

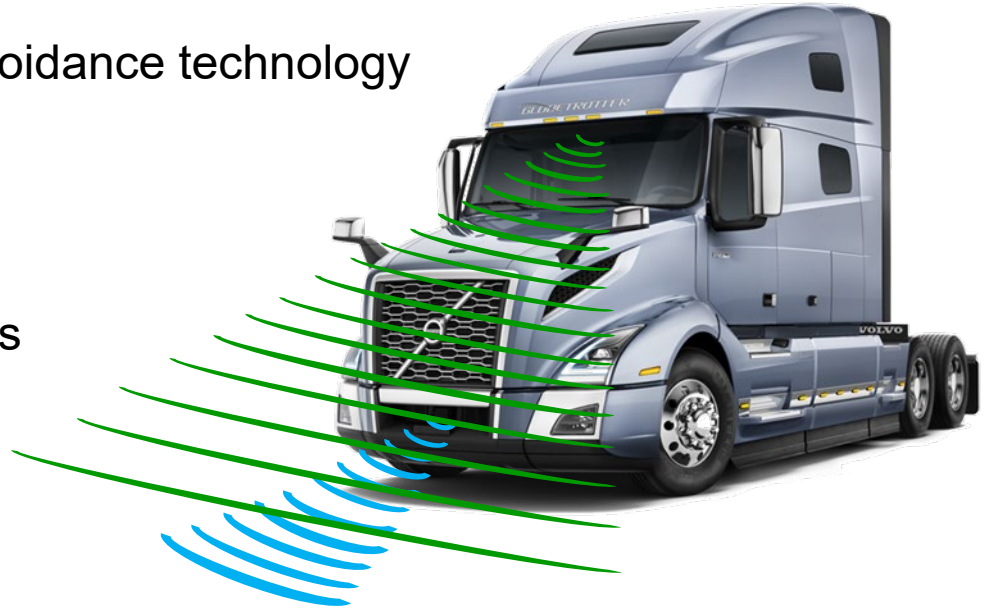

# Volvo Active Driver Assist

- Next generation in forward collision avoidance technology
- Now standard (Volvo first)!

## Helps driver reduce crash risk:

- Tracks and prioritizes multiple vehicles
- Helps maintain safe driving distance
- Alerts driver to most critical situation
- Automatic braking assist
