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#### TRUCKING IS ESSENTIAL

## ATA STRATEGIC PRIORITIES FOR 2018 ATA Active Role

- Federal Preemption of State Regulation of Interstate Trucking (F4A)
- > Transportation Infrastructure Funding
- > Trade
- Autonomous Vehicles
- > Protecting the Independent Contractor
- Addressing Workforce Development
- > Technical Improvements HOS

#### **HOURS-OF-SERVICE**

- Expanding the current 100 air-mile "short-haul" exemption from 12 hours on-duty to 14 hours on-duty;
- Extending the current 14-hour on-duty limitation by up to two hours when a truck driver encounters adverse conditions;
- Revising the current mandatory 30-minute break for truck drivers after 8-hours of continuous driving; and
- ➤ Reinstating the option for splitting up the required 10-hour off-duty rest break for drivers operating trucks that are equipped with a sleeper-berth compartment.



#### COST OF UNDERINVESTMENT



Congestion on U.S. National Highway System cost the trucking industry \$81B in 2016



- Lost productivity due to congestion= 1.3 Billion hours
  - Equates to 463,000 commercial drivers sitting idle for entire year

#### COST OF UNDERINVESTMENT



➤ A motorist loses on average \$523 annually - \$112 billion nationally - in vehicle repair costs due to unmaintained roads (pot holes)




➤ 88% of National Highway System (NHS) congestion occurs on just 17% of the network and can be solved by eliminating major bottlenecks




## ATA SOLUTION: THE BUILD AMERICA FUND PROPOSAL

- ➤ A new 20 cent per gallon fee built into the price of transportation fuels collected at the terminal rack
- Phased in over four years (five cent increase per year). The increase is assumed to begin on January 1, 2019.
- Once fully phased in, the fee will be double indexed to inflation and improvements in fuel efficiency.

#### **SUPPORTS FUEL TAX**


- ➤ President Trump backed a 25cent increase during a bipartisan meeting with lawmakers


#### Truck Driver Shortage

# ATA WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT POLICY COMMITTEE 18 TO 21 YEAR OLDS AS INTERSTATE TRUCK

**DRIVERS** 

- ➤ The FAST Act of 2015 created a DOT pilot program allowing 18-21 year old military truck drivers to drive across state lines;
- Legislation known as the WHEEL Act was introduced in September to expand this pilot project to include civilian CMV drivers;
- ➤ Only 28% of schools in America offer programs that highlight trucking as a career.


